- 2. Development/Implementation of a secure digital business technology platform that would host different applications and services and development of mobile and web-based application(s) to be hosted on the platform in the areas required by the SMEs.

The local digital solution providers are expected to

- 1) Conduct visits in the assigned enterprise to drive and conduct the requirements capture for the digital project with the NPCC project team.
- 2) Compile and deliver the detailed workplan, business case and provide the solution architecture, projects systems analysis and design methodology, project implementation and documentation within budget and timeframe.
- 3) Provide a weekly status update to the NPCC project team during the development stage of the project.

- 4) Conduct and provide a user acceptance test (UAT) report of the developed solution.
- 5) Provide as part of the systems documentation a user manual for capacity building and conduct on the job training during the go-live stage of the project.
